



Fact sheet – NHS England Data Flow

A proportion of Just Drop-in's counselling and mentoring sessions are funded by NHS England via the Eastern Cheshire Clinical Commissioning Group or the Local Authority. Therefore, Just Drop-in are asked to report some basic data to NHS England about the number of beneficiaries we support and the number of sessions we provide on a monthly basis. Because this means Just Drop-in would be sharing your data with another organisation, it's important we let you know about this and give you the opportunity to opt out:

The data we are asked to share with NHS England is:

- Your date of birth
- Your postcode
- Your gender
- Your ethnicity
- The date of your appointments

What is NOT shared:

- Your name
- Your full address
- What you discuss in sessions

NHS England then include this information as part of the 'Mental Health Service Data Set' (MHSDS) to keep track of the number of young people and young adults gaining support in the UK.

MHSDS data is used for:

- commissioning services
- clinical audit
- research
- service planning
- inspection and regulation
- monitoring government policies and legislation
- local and national performance management and benchmarking
- national reporting and analysis

MHSDS data is NOT used for:

- Telling your GP or other medical professionals that you are accessing services
- It does not become recorded on your NHS medical records
